Request

I am a vet undertaking a PhD in dairy goat health and production and am currently trying to obtain up to date figures for commercial dairy goat farms in the UK (i.e. farms producing milk for sale for human consumption). I am interested in the numbers dairy goat farms in the UK and the sizes of these farms in terms of numbers of goats.

Response

You referred to a previous FOI from March 2016 providing the same information. The FSA has therefore released this information in the same format using the same parameters.

The list provided on the following page provides the numbers of all dairy goat farms in England and Wales only, which were registered with FSA to sell to consumers as of December 18th 2017. The list has 123 separate registered establishments; I have also included the number of goats on the farms as requested. For information please note that such establishments register with and are inspected by the FSA. However, any sampling is in arrangement with the Local Authorities. In preparing this information, the FSA has identified registered dairy establishments, which have goats and how many goats they have. You will note that there are some zeros which is presumed relate to farms registered to produce goat milk but not yet in possession of any goats.

As stated above the list provided covers England and Wales. I understand you have requested information for UK however we have not been able to provide you with this as we do not hold this information.

I would recommend that if you require similar figures and/or information for Scotland and Northern Ireland you contact the appropriate respective bodies separately.

Please be aware that any dairy related matters in Scotland are the responsibility of the Local Authorities. For further information, I would recommend you therefore contact the Scottish Local Authorities. For information relating to goat dairy farming in Northern Ireland I would suggest you initially contact DAERA at https://www.daera-ni.gov.uk/contact.
