2. The number of criminal prosecutions against individuals or businesses the Food Standards Agency launches each year.

Please provide the data broken down by individuals and businesses for each of the last five years with a year-end 30th November, or whichever year-end date is most convenient. If you cannot provide data for each of the last five years, then please give data for each of the last three years. If that is not possible, then please give data for each of the two most recent years.

 The attached table details the total value of fines handed down by the courts following prosecutions taken by the Food Standards Agency in each of the last five years for the periods ending on 30 November. The fines are collected by HM Courts and Tribunal Service not the FSA. The FSA does not impose any administrative penalties.
